**Apple** Pink Lady, Gala, Jonagold, Crispin, Golden Delicious, Holland, Newtown Pippin, Jersey mac, Anna, Mollie's Delicious, Fuji, Granny Smith, Ein Shemer, Esopus Spitzenberg, Arkansas Black

**Apricot (May fruit every 2-4 years due to early blooming)** Moorpark, Bryan, Hungarian, Blenheim

**Aprium** Cot-N-Candy, Summer Delight

**Bay Laurel** Angustifolia, Emerald Wave, Little Ragu, Sweet Bay

**Blackberry** Natchez, Ouachita, Kiowa, Navajo, Arapaho, Brazos, Womack, Shawnee, Rosborough, Prime Ark Freedom

**Blueberry (Best if planted in large containers with amended media)** Tiftblue, Woodard, Brightwell, Climax

**Citrus \*** (\*Should be planted with protection from North Wind. Consider covering when temperatures fall below 15 degrees F.

**Satsuma** Artic Frost, Owari, Kimbrough **Tangerine** Changsha, Ten Degree **Kumquat** Marumi, 'Meiwa', 'Nagami' **Citrangequat** Thomasville **Japanese Lemon** Yuzu

**Must be planted in pots and brought inside during freezing temps) Lemon** 'Meyer', Variegated Pink', **Lime** 'Mexican', 'Mary Ellen', Australian Red Finger Lime

**Che (Melon Berry)** Darrow, Norris

**Cherry (Sour)** Montmorency, Dwarf North Star **Cherry (Nanking)** Seedlings

**Cherry (Sweet)** Minnie Royal, Royal Lee, Lapins, Royal Rainier

**Clove Currant** Crandall, Seedlings

**Elderberry** Bob Gordon, Wildwood, Ranch, Johns, Adams, Black Lace, Native Seedlings

**Fig** Violette de Bordeaux, Celeste, Alma, Panache, Texas Blue Giant, LSU Purple, Italian Honey, Texas Everbearing, Ronde De Bordeaux, Figo Preto, Saint Rita, Brown Turkey

**Grapes: (for home viticulture)** Champanel, Lomanto, Miss Blanc, Southern Home, Victoria Red **Muscadine-** Triumph, Better adapted to acidic soils: Magnolia, Carlos, Noble (red wine cultivar), Ison's, Fry, Tara, Nesbit

**Goji (Wolfberry)** Phoenix Tears, Big Lifeberry, Vermilion

**Goumi** Sweet Scarlet, Red Gem

**Pineapple Guava** Andre, Besson, Coolidge, Mammoth, Nazemetz, Seedlings

**Honeyberry \*(Avoid Western Sun)** Blue Velvet, Berry Blue, Blue Pacific

**Jujube** Shanxi Li, Sugarcane, Honeyjar, Li, Lang, Tigertooth

**Juneberry \*(Avoid Western Sun)** Regent, Blue Profusion

**Hardy Kiwi** Ken's Red, Anna, Meyer's

**Loquat (May fruit every 2-4 years due to early blooming)** Big Jim, Tanaka, Advance, Gold Nugget, Vista White, Seedlings

**Mulberry** Illinois Everbearing, Gerardi, Collier, Riviera, Pakistan, Kaester

**Nectarine (May fruit every 2-4 years due to early blooming)** Smooth Texan Two, Smooth Texan Three, Double Delight, Snow Queen

### **Peach**

**Early:** Sentinel, Ranger, Harvester, Flat Delight Two

**Mid-season:** Elberta, Redglobe, Milam, Majestic, Denman, Loring, Belle of Georgia, Bounty, Babcock, Royal Zest Three, White Zest One

**Late:** Dixieland, Redskin, Jefferson, Flame Prince

**Very late:** Frank, Fayette, Ouachita Gold

\*'Lovell' Rootstocks perform better in alkaline clay soils

**Peach (Dwarf)** Bonanza II, Bonfire, Early Golden Glory

**Pear** Orient, Moonglow, Kieffer, LeConte, Ayres, Garber, Maxine, Warren, Seckle, Magness, Monterrey

**Pear (Asian)** Shinseiki, 20th Century, Hosui

**Pecan** Caddo, Sioux, Western, Pawnee, Desirable, Choctaw, Kiowa, Cape Fear

**Persimmon** Eureka, Tane-nashi, Tamopan, Giant Fuyu, Coffee Cake, Izu

**Plum** Santa Rosa, Methley, Bruce, Morris, Ozark Premier, Burgundy, Emerald Beaut

**Pluot** Flavor King, Splash, Flavor Grenade, Dapple Dandy, Flavor Supreme, Elephant Heart
