## PINK AUTUMN SAGE



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	2-3'	<b>Character</b>	Semi-evergreen
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2-3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Pink	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** A semi-evergreen Texas native shrub planted for its colorful and long blooming soft pink flowers that attract hummingbirds and pollinators alike. It's extremely heat and drought tolerant. The nativar 'pink' is one of our favorites producing dense flushes of deep, pink-colored blooms.



## FLAME ACANTHUS



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	3-4'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	3-4'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Red	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** Also known as hummingbird bush, this Texas native shrubby perennial planted for its showy red and orange long-blooming flowers which attract both hummingbirds and butterflies. It's very easy to grow in sunny spots with good drainage and can withstand even the sunniest spot with blistering summer sun!



## WHITE MISTFLOWER



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	2-4'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2-3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	White	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** One of the best plants for attracting fall-migrating monarch butterflies and native pollinators, autumn-blooming white mistflower is hard to beat! When summer temperatures begin to fade, dense white flower clusters explode, almost completely covering the tops of its attractive green foliage. Also known as shrubby white bonset, this evergreen sub-shrub adaptable and easy to grow, it often forms a tall ground-cover which works as a virtual stop sign for fall migrating Monarchs.



## WHITE GAURA



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	2-3'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	1-2'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	White	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** An easy to grow native perennial planted for its showy butterfly-like flowers that sit atop arching stems and appear to dance in the wind. Its dark-green to gray-green leaves are also of interest, turning red, to purple in fall. Gaura is also a frequent stop as a nectar source of many native pollinators.



## TEXAS LANTANA



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	3-6'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2-5'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun
<b>Flower Color</b>	Orange, Red, Yellow	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** This Texas native variety of Lantana, *L. urticoides* is an extremely heat and drought tolerant large shrubby perennial that produces clusters of long-blooming, showy red, orange, and yellow flowers. Unlike many of its shorter non-native cousins, Texas lantana is cold hardy, regrowing from its root base each spring.



## TEXAS ROCK ROSE



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	3'	<b>Character</b>	Semi-evergreen
<b>Plant Spread</b>	3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Pink	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** This heat and drought tolerant native shrubby perennial produces dense miniature pink colored hibiscus-like flowers from spring through fall which can be frequented by a number of pollinators. When this plant is happy, its truly a show-stopper with dense blooms that last throughout the season!



## WRIGHT'S SKULLCAP



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	1'	<b>Character</b>	Evergreen
<b>Plant Spread</b>	1-2'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun
<b>Flower Color</b>	Purple	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** A low-growing evergreen perennial that is covered in small purple blooms spring through summer and sometimes into fall. Bees and butterflies will often frequent this tough showy Texas native.



## 'HENRY DUELBERG' SALVIA



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	2-3'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2-3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Purple	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** 'Henry Duelberg' produces highly ornamental upright spikes of dark blue flowers that bloom spring to fall. This nativar is a reliable drought tolerant perennial and has become somewhat of an industry standard for its super showy blooms, adored by gardeners and pollinators alike.



## ZEXMENIA



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	2'	<b>Character</b>	Semi-evergreen
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Yellow	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** A native perennial planted for a dense canopy of showy, mounding yellow flowers. Zemenia is so easy to grow it is also referred to as a "miracle plant" because of its versatility, cold and drought tolerance and long booming period.



## FALL ASTER



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	2-3'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	4'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Purple	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low to Medium

**Description** This native perennial aster produces dazzling purple mounds of fragrant, daisy-like flowers with yellow center disks. Its super easy to grow and as its name implies, it provides an outstanding floral display in cooler months.



## TURK'S CAP



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Spring, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	4'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun, Part-Full Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Red	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** A versatile Texas native shrubby perennial that produces flushes of red blooms in even the shadiest spots. Easy to grow and often self-spreading.



## GREGG'S MISTFLOWER



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Summer, Fall
<b>Mature Height</b>	1-2'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2-3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun to Part Shade
<b>Flower Color</b>	Blue	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** If you were to choose one plant for attracting butterflies and native pollinators, Gregg's mistflower is hard to beat! Summer through fall powdery blue flower clusters almost completely cover the tops of its lacey green foliage. It is so adaptable and easy to grow, it often forms a tall groundcover which works as a virtual stop sign for fall migrating Monarchs.



## WINE CUP



<b>Plant Type</b>	Perennial	<b>Bloom Time</b>	Summer
<b>Mature Height</b>	1'	<b>Character</b>	Deciduous
<b>Plant Spread</b>	2-3'	<b>Light Requirement</b>	Full Sun
<b>Flower Color</b>	Magenta	<b>Water Requirement</b>	Low

**Description** Excellent native ground cover easily grown in dry to medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun. Grows well from seed and may self-seed in the garden in optimum growing conditions.
