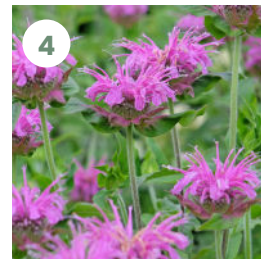

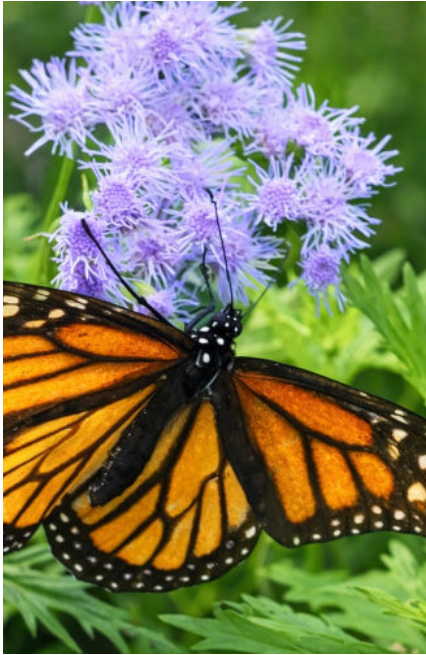

GREGG'S MISTFLOWER

Conoclinium greggii



If you were to choose one plant for attracting butterflies and native pollinators, Gregg's mistflower is hard to beat! In late spring through fall powdery blue flower clusters almost completely cover the tops of its lacy green foliage. It is so adaptable and easy to grow, it often forms a tall groundcover which works as a virtual stop sign for fall migrating monarchs.

PITCHER SAGE

Salvia azurea



A clump-forming Texas native perennial known for its whorls of two-lipped, azure blue flowers. It grows easily in average, dry to medium, well-drained soil and prefers sunny locations. Drought tolerant and deer resistant. For a more compact shape and to prevent stems from flopping, cut the plant back by up to half in late spring. Stems are more likely to flop when over watered.

HENRY DUELBURG SALVIA

Salvia farinacea



'Henry Duelberg' produces highly ornamental upright spikes of dark lavender blue flowers that bloom spring to fall. This wild-selected nativar is a reliable drought tolerant perennial and has become somewhat of an industry standard for its long-blooming super showy flowers, adored by gardeners and pollinators alike.

WILD BERGAMOT

Monarda fistulosa



Also known as bee balm, this Texas native perennial is highly adaptable and produces long blooming whorls of pink to lavender flowers that attract a number of pollinators and hummingbirds. Its leaves have historically been used to make a tea, which is how it got its common name.

FALL ASTER

Symphyotrichum oblongifolium



A native perennial aster that produces dazzling purple mounds of fragrant daisy-like flowers with yellow center disks. Easy to grow and provides an outstanding floral display in cooler months, just in time for the monarch migration.

ENGELMANN DAISY

Engelmannia peristenia



Long-blooming Texas native with cheerful yellow flowers and a deep taproot that thrives in heat and drought. Blooms open each morning and close by afternoon, drawing bees and butterflies from spring through summer, while coarse silvery-green foliage keeps its low mound attractive even when it's not blooming.

TEXAS BLAZING STAR

Liatris pycnostachya



Vertical spikes of purple flowers covered in butterflies and native bees during late season. Dramatic flower spikes add striking height and texture to the garden, standing out even among other bloomers nearby. Easy to grow in average soil and remarkably drought tolerant once established, it's a reliable performer that rewards minimal care with maximum pollinator traffic.

ROUGH CONEFLOWER

Rudbeckia grandiflora



Rhizomatous prairie perennial with large golden flowers that creates bold summer color. Its tall, sturdy stems rise above coarse foliage and hold up well in the heat, spreading gradually by rhizome to form a fuller drift over time. Bees and butterflies flock to the blooms, making it as valuable for pollinators as it is eye-catching in the border.

NARROWLEAF CONEFLOWER

Echinacea angustifolia



A hardy, drought-tolerant North Texas native perennial that features slender, lance-shaped leaves and distinctive drooping purple to pink daisy-like flowers with a spiny, cone-shaped center. Blooming from late spring to summer, it attracts pollinators like bees and butterflies.

RATTLESNAKE MASTER

Eryngium yuccifolium



Often hard to find in nurseries, this striking North Texas native evergreen perennial is a bit of an enigma with its unusual yucca-like foliage and showy white thistle-like blooms. Spring, summer and fall this tough Texas native provides a striking show for both people and pollinators.
